Assessments for the scholarships are based on submissions, giving students a chance to highlight their commitment, achievements and contributions to school life and the wider community.

There are a variety of fee remissions awarded, including up to 90% remission of the annual tuition fees until the end of Year 12.

The scholarship does not cost anything to submit an application. When a child is awarded a scholarship, a \$150 confirmation of place fee will need to be paid to confirm their place. This will be deducted from the Term 4 fees.

Terms and Conditions of Scholarship

1. Scholarships are awarded by Lakeside College to recognise and support outstanding students in their endeavours. In receiving a Scholarship, students will be expected to complete their academic studies through to the end of year 12 at Lakeside College. Students who subsequently accept a Scholarship or Offer of Enrolment from another school may be required to repay all Scholarship amounts received.
2. The College reserves the right not to make an award if the standard of the applicants does not warrant it doing so. The Scholarship Committee has discretion as to the number and monetary value of all Scholarships.
3. Parents and students are informed that it is a condition of a Scholarship being awarded, that the value of the Scholarship remains confidential between the family, student and the College.
4. Scholarships are for the duration of a student's education at Lakeside College, unless otherwise stated, and subject to review as per cl. 6
5. Recipients of Scholarships are expected to maintain a high level of academic and behavioural standards.
6. Scholarships are reviewed annually and may be reduced or terminated if a recipient's progress, attitude or conduct is considered unsatisfactory.
7. Scholarships may also be reviewed should a family's compliance with school policies (including fee policy i.e. Fees) be considered unsatisfactory.
8. The information on the application form, results of tests, interviews and any other information provided remains confidential.
9. Scholarship application closing dates are set by Lakeside College.
10. The Academic Scholarship test will be held on a day determined by the College.
11. Scholarships are not available to overseas full-fee paying students.
12. An invitation to attend an interview does not mean that the student will necessarily be offered a Scholarship.
13. The College will not enter into any discussion regarding the awarding of the scholarship. Following the interview process, offers will be made in writing by the Principal. Any offers of scholarships not accepted by the due date will be rescinded.
14. All applicants, both successful and unsuccessful, will be notified in writing.
15. A discount of 5% is available to families who wish to pay one (1) full year tuition fees in advance payable by the 28th February 2020.
16. Scholarships will be offered in addition to the sibling discount. All Scholarships are offered at the discretion of the Principal.
